Sacramental Preparation Classes

Information on Sacramental Preparations is now available on the parish website. All those wishing to receive First Holy Communion or Confirmation must sign up via the website before 17th February 2019. Please note that Sacramental Preparation classes are for registered parishioners only. **Classes begin at 9:00am on Sunday 24th February 2019.** Classes are of 14 weeks duration excluding Palm Sunday, Easter Sunday and Low Sunday.

First Holy Communion will be made during the 10:15am on Sunday 23rd June (Feast of Corpus Christi).

Confirmation, conferred by Bishop Waltersheid Auxiliary Bishop of Pittsburg, will be celebrated on Saturday 29th June (Feast of Ss. Peter & Paul) at 10am followed by Pontifical Benediction. **For those receiving this sacrament who were not baptized at St. Michaels please arrange for a baptism certificate (dated within the last six months) to be sent to the Rectory now.**
