First Friday: The week seeing the First Friday of June. Please make every effort to pay homage to the Sacred Heart of Jesus by attending the parish Holy Hour at 5:00pm followed by Mass at 6:00pm.

First Holy Communion: First Holy Communion will be received this year on Sunday 23rd June the External Solemnity of the Feast of Corpus Christi. Weather depending the parish will celebrate this occasion and the Feast of the body of Our Lord with a Eucharistic procession following the 10:15am High Mass. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to participate.

The Sacrament of Confirmation: Confirmation will be bestowed by Bishop William Walterschied on those deemed worthy in the parish on Saturday 29th June (Feast of Ss. Peter & Paul). The ceremony will take place at 10:00am. Those to be confirmed are asked to attend Mass at 9:00am in preparation and to make use of the sacrament of confession in the week before receiving Confirmation. Volunteers are sought to provide light refreshments for the Confirmandi and the bishop after the ceremony.
