Sacramental Preparation: This year the parish will not be offering the Sacrament of Confirmation as we enter the 2 years cycle for the administration of this sacrament. As such there will be no sacramental preparation classes in 2020. This sacrament will be administered in June 2021 with preparation classes beginning in January of the same year.

Sacramental preparation classes for those eligible to make their First Holy Communion.

Holy Communion is usually received by children who will have achieved their seventh year before 1st June and is accompanied by first Confession the day before reception. Sacramental Preparation classes are carried out in the hall of St. Michael the Archangel every Sunday from January to May. Each class begins promptly at 9am. Parents who wish their children to receive First Holy Communion on 14 June 2020 (External Solemnity of Corpus Christi) should enroll their child by the First Sunday of Advent. Registration forms will be available in the vestibule from next Sunday.
