Diocesan Annual Appeal: Appeal envelopes are in the vestibule. Please make sure that you donate something to the Annual Appeal. The Parish Code is #060. The in pew collection for the Annual Appeal will take place this week Sunday 27th October. **Therefore there will be a second collection for in pew envelopes today please use the envelop provided in pew.**

Feast of Christ the King (Sunday 27th October): This year the Feast of Christ the King will be marked by a period of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the Consecration of the Human Race. The High Mass will conclude with Exposition and parishioners are encouraged to spend sometime in quiet contemplation of Christ the King. Benediction will take place at 12:45pm.

All Saints & All Souls: The Feast of All Saints falls on Friday 1st November and will be celebrated in the parish with High Mass at 6:00pm. **In order to prepare for Mass there will be NO Adoration at 5pm on Friday 1 November.**

This year parishioners are encouraged to make use of the FSSP All Souls Novena available at fssp.com/novenas to remember the faithful departed. The parish will remember our deceased benefactors at a High Mass on Saturday 2nd November at 9:00am. This Mass will immediately be followed by two additional Low Masses for the souls of the faithful departed.

All Saints Party: The annual All Saints Party for children will take place after the 10:15am High Mass on Sunday 3 November in the church hall.

Sacramental preparation classes for those eligible to make their First Holy Communion.

Holy Communion is usually received by children who will have achieved their seventh year before 1st June and is accompanied by first Confession the day before reception. Sacramental Preparation classes are carried out in the hall of St. Michael the Archangel every Sunday from January to May. Each class begins promptly at 9am. Parents who wish their children to receive First Holy Communion on 14 June 2020 (External Solemnity of Corpus Christi) should enroll their child by the First Sunday of Advent.
