Stations of the Cross: As we enter the penitential season of Lent the devotion of the parish shifts from Christ in the Most Holy Eucharist to Christ Crucified. Therefore, for the season of Lent the Friday public devotion of Eucharist Adoration is replaced by Stations of Cross at 5pm followed by Rosary and Confessions.
