**Feast of the Assumption:** This year the Feast of the Assumption falls on Saturday 15th August and will be celebrated with a High Mass at 9:00am. Due to the preparation necessary for Mass there will be no Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament before Mass. However the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed immediately after Mass until Noon.

**Altar Servers:** As we approach the 15th August and the return to the High Mass schedule ALL current servers are to report for training on **Saturday 8th August immediately after the 9:00am Mass**. The practice will last no more than an hour. If there are any boys who have made their first communion and are not already scheduled this is also your opportunity to register and receive training.

**High Mass schedule:** The High Mass schedule including a server schedule will be posted on the parish website on Monday 10th August. Please ensure that all servers check the schedule ahead of a resumption of High Masses on Saturday 15th August.

**Photo Policy:** The Pastor reminds you that when visiting St Michaels you are in the presence of the Most Blessed Sacrament and that all due reverence should be given to Our Lord. It is therefore not appropriate to take pictures during Mass and or the sermon. He also reminds you that it is a necessary act of charity to ask the permission of the subject before taking and/or posting any photographs online or sharing them electronically. This is particularly important when the subject is a minor and where parental consent is required by law. The standing policy of St Michaels is to forbid the taking, posting or reproducing of any images taken inside the church or on church property unless express permission to the contrary has been granted by the Pastor.
