Prayer for Ecclesiastical & Civil Leaders: The prayer for our church and civil leaders is posted on the parish website and on fssp.com. This prayer will be added to all liturgies at St. Michaels during the month of October in addition to the October Prayer to St. Joseph. ALL parishioners are requested to united their intentions with these prayers and to recite them at home.

First Friday & Saturday: This coming weekend begins the month of October and First Friday Mass and Confessions are available at the usual times. During this month parishioners are asked to recite the prayer to St. Joseph and make every attempt to make a visit to the church to spend some time in silent prayer for the intentions of the parish and our civil and ecclesiastical leaders in preparation for the Feast of Christ the King on 25th October. To facilitate this the Blessed Sacrament will be simply exposed for an hour after every morning Mass and after the Sunday High Mass. The church will also be opened between the hours of 6pm and 7pm on Wednesdays and Fridays throughout October for private prayer.
