Collections Envelops: Apologies once again but collection envelops have not yet arrived. Hopefully they will arrive by next week. Please note that due to the parish census your box number may have changed. Please check the name and address on the box before removing. If you do not have an envelop box it means that you are not a registered parishioner of St Michaels or have not contributed to the parish in the last year. To register simply complete the census form available in the vestibule and hand it in to the rectory or place it in the collection basket. Thank you.

Registration for Sacramental Preparation: The sign up form for registration for First Holy Communion and Confirmation preparation is available in the vestibule until the end of January. First Holy Communions are tentatively scheduled for 10:15am Sunday 6th June 2021 (Feast of Corpus Christi) and Confirmation for 5:00pm Friday 11th June (Feast of the Sacred Heart). Preparation classes will be held in the Church Hall (with social distancing) at 9:00am each Sunday beginning on 24th January 2021. Attendance at preparation classes is mandatory. N.B. mindful of Covid restrictions the Pastor has obtained the delegated permission to celebrate the sacrament of confirmation.

North American Provincial: Please keep Fr. William Lawrence F.S.S.P. in your prayers as he prepares to take over as North American Provincial in July. Fr. William Lawrence was born on October 4, 1976. He obtained a Bachelor's Degree in Chemical Engineering before entering OLGs in 1999. After seven years of formation he was ordained a priest on June 3, 2006. After ordination he worked in St. Catharines, Ontario as Assistant Chaplain and then Chaplain until the fall of 2009. He was also responsible for Sunday Masses in the Dioceses of London and Hamilton, Ontario. After two years spent in Washington, DC obtaining a Licentiate in Sacred Theology from the Dominican House of Studies, he was transferred to OLGs where he took responsibility for the Spirituality year and worked as Vocations Director and Director of Seminarian Apostolates. Fr. Lawrence has served on the Board of Trustees of Our Lady of Fatima Chapel in Pequannock, NJ since 2008. He also served on the North American District Council from 2010 until he joined the seminary in 2011 and as a member of the Board of Directors of the North American District from 2014 - 2017. The General Chapter in 2018 elected him one of the counsellors to the Superior General.
