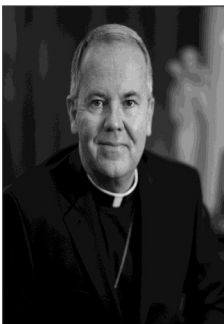
Dear Faithful of St. Michael the Archangel,

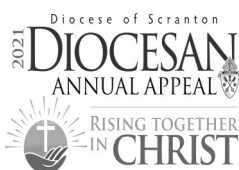
