By praying the "Our Father" we commend ourselves under the Fatherhood of God and place our trust in Him. When we say the "Hail Mary," we repeatedly ask our Mother and Queen to be with us at the hour of our death. All the while we contemplate the mysteries of our salvation. By reverencing these truths through this prayer we keep the light of faith burning in our hearts.

4. The Rosary will cause virtue and good works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God; it will withdraw the hearts of men from the love of the world and its vanities, and will lift them to the desire for eternal things. Oh, that souls would sanctify themselves by this means.
5. The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the Rosary, shall not perish.
6. Whoever shall recite the Rosary devoutly, applying himself to the consideration of its sacred mysteries shall never be conquered by misfortune. God will not chastise him in His justice, he shall not perish by an unprovided death; if he be just he shall remain in the grace of God, and become worthy of eternal life.
